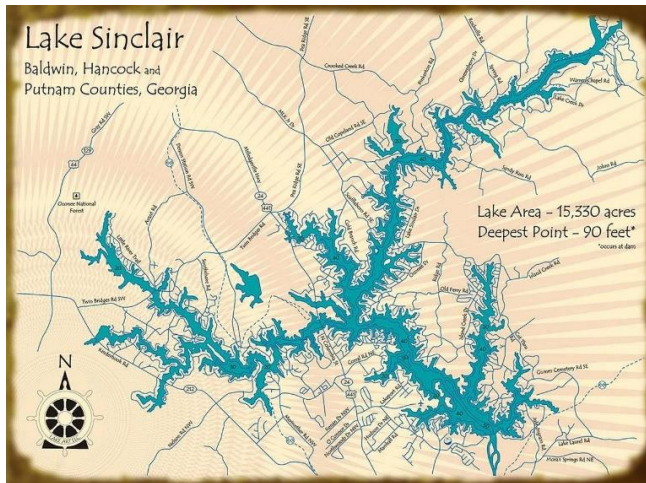

Lake Sinclair encompasses 15,300 acres of coves and several large areas of open water. Created by [Georgia Power](#) in 1953, the lake was named after Benjamin W. Sinclair, a Georgia Power official. The lake is located two hours Southeast of Atlanta, providing easy access to



recreational activities including fishing, swimming, boating, and camping. Several marinas offer boat slips and amenities.

Lake Sinclair boasts over 500 miles of scenic shoreline with public boat ramps, picnic areas and beaches. With Milledgeville's mild climate, watercraft of all shapes and sizes can be found on the lake year-round.

Several wooden boat enthusiasts and member of ABCS call Lake Sinclair home. The Blue Ridge Chapter of ACBS hosts its fall boat show, the Lake Sinclair Classic & Wooden Boat Show, at Little River Park and Marina, located at 3069 Columbia Street in Milledgeville, GA.
